- Provide computer-assisted instruction using language learning software & websites to complement theme-based lessons;
- Design assessment tasks for on-going evaluation of learners' progress based on the Canadian Language Benchmarks and PBLA guidelines;
- Adhere to the assigned class schedule and work cooperatively with LINC Supervisor, Program Assistant and regular teachers to maintain program quality;
- To maintain good attendance ratio to meet funding requirements;
- Assist in program related activities and/or tasks assigned by the LINC Supervisor.
