The Lead Teacher will design, plan, prepare, and deliver virtual or in-person English language instruction based on the CLB and LINC Curriculum Guidelines, integrating life skills to support settlement and adaptation to an English-speaking environment. In addition, the role serves as the PBLA Lead, acting as a resource person to guide and support LINC instructors in the effective implementation of Portfolio-Based Language Assessment (PBLA).

Responsibilities:

- Design, implement and instruct LINC students based on the CLB and PBLA Guidelines, both online and in-person;
- Design PBLA-based module plans as well as daily lesson plans following the Revised CLB 2012 and LINC Curriculum Guidelines;
- Provide computer-assisted instruction using language learning software & websites to complement theme-based lessons;
- Design assessment tasks for ongoing evaluation of learners' progress based on the Canadian Language Benchmarks and PBLA guidelines;
- Adhere to the assigned class schedules and work cooperatively with LINC Coordinator, Program
 Assistant, and regular teachers to maintain program quality;
- Keep current with PBLA standards, practices and resources by accessing the Center for Canadian Language Benchmarks (CCLB) website and participating in the discussions on the PBLA Implementation Forum;
- Act as a resource and meet one-on-one with LINC teachers to ensure PBLA implementation
- Provide PBLA orientation, training and support to new LINC Instructors including casual and contract instructors;



- Deliver workshops related to PBLA implementation and provide support in planning the annual PD Day event;
- Advise the LINC Coordinator on program policy or practice changes that may be required to facilitate
 PBLA implementation and on needed supports such as program development and/or resources;
- Provide leadership to special projects, as required;
- Work collaboratively in a team environment with other PBLA Leads;
- Assist in program-related activities and/or tasks assigned by the LINC Supervisor.
